

## **CORWIN COLLECTION INVENTORY, 1920s-1960s**

### **ABSTRACT**

Douglas Corwin was a pharmacist in Pineville, North Carolina. Prior to leaving North Carolina for Wisconsin, he and his wife decided to donate their collection of Pineville materials to local institutions so that the information would be retained in the area.

The majority of the collection concerns two Pineville businesses: the Pineville Drug Company, and the Merchants and Farmers Bank in Pineville. Additional materials from Pineville businesses are also included in the collection.

This collection contains artifacts, blueprints, books, documents, and ledgers.
