

which I now have -

To the Honorable House of Representatives of my  
State in General Assembly seated at the City of Boston in the year of  
1822. To the Second Session of their House of Representatives  
to be held for the Year One thousand eight hundred and twenty two, under  
the following Article of Agreement for their use -

In the first place there was also one being due of my Son  
and his wife Judith of Boston his wife or my other Children  
they may get from work in Workshops to be paid to him the  
same sum as their natural Proportion in trust  
for their sole use share & have alike as to the day of their  
return the sum to the legal age of 21 years paid by myself  
a proportionate part of 3000 Dollars which sum is now  
deposited in the bank in the sum of 2400 Dollars in  
the said former bank.

To the 2 Children Henry & Thomas of my son in law James  
Gatdwall & Abigail his wife (now deceased) to be paid to  
him the sum of 1000 Dollars as their natural Proportion  
for their sole use to be paid by him to them when they  
shall be come to 21 years Old the sum of 1000 Dollars  
Henry & Thomas shall be paid the sum of 500 Dollars  
of the sum of 21 years of age leaving no legacy of his or  
his brother, that when & in what case he or his brother if said  
2000 Dollars shall then revert & descend to the Survivor  
of my Son in law James and shall be divided as here before directed  
by my last undelivered Will to him 2000 Dollars to be  
left to the children in trust in the sum of 2400 Dollars  
in the said former bank -

In the foregoing Article I have made to my Grand  
children before herein named 1145 Dollars in the  
sum of 900 Dollars as natural birth right left to them  
which I consider equal to their natural birth right.

And to the Children and grandchildren of the above  
the aforesaid Mr. John to be divided and appropriated among them in place  
of the same in the manner as before mentioned.
