ABSTRACT

American Legion Baseball was founded in 1925 "to give young men an opportunity to develop their skills, personal fitness, leadership qualities, and to have fun." The league has had numerous participants go on to the National Baseball League, and prominence in other fields, and continues to promote opportunities for young men. To be eligible for the Senior League, players must be 19 and under, with participants ages 13-17 placed in the Junior League.
