

## **CHARLOTTE ARCHERS CLUB COLLECTION, 1930-1970**

### **ABSTRACT**

The Charlotte Archers Club was organized in 1930, with the first Archery Range located at Independence Park. The club reorganized and moved several times over the next few years, and eventually settled in Latta Park in Dilworth, in 1938. The same year, on October 23, the Charlotte Archers elected officers, with Dr. B.A. Southerland serving as President. The purpose of the club was to promote and enjoy the sport of archery, and furnish a place for archers to shoot and enjoy fellowship with their fellow archers. Never a large organization, the Charlotte Archers Club eventually disbanded in the 1960s due to lack of additional membership.

This collection includes documents, photographs, and an artifact.
