Each identifies various activities of the committees that included War, Hospital, Social, Benevolent, Credential, Publicity, Telephone, Veterans, and Old Confederate Woman's Home, Children of the Confederacy, Southern Literature for home and foreign libraries. Also lists members in chapter, past presidents, officers, North Carolina Division officers and rituals of the UDC.

*United Daughters of the Confederacy* (1912-1916) Mildred Lewis Rutherford, historian for the UDC, lectured on various subjects concerning the recording of southern history.

HS4BCC Battle of Charlotte Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution. Organized 1909. Eight items 1920-36 with some years missing. Year books: 1920-1929 and 1935-36. Lists officers, committee members, chairpersons and membership roster.

Besides the monthly topic, the programs list the officers, committee members, the hostess, the presenter, the day of the meting and members' addresses and telephone numbers. Also contains an undated newspaper clipping, three lectures of different years prepared by one of the members.

# **LS40AU** Au Courant Book Club Organized in 1931.

Programs from 1934-1954 with some years missing. Each monthly program contains discussion topics, officers, committee members with their addresses, telephone numbers, meeting date, hostess and presenter.

#### LS41BD

Bessie Dewey Book Club. Organized in 1894. Named in honor of Bessie Lacy Dewey, the only librarian of the Charlotte Library and Literary Association. Papers include a list of Charlotte book clubs in 1905 and 1906. Program of 1905-06, handwritten list of Scottish literature and history. Programs of 1913-14, 1922-23, which provides members' names and discussion topics. A 1924 pamphlet describes the dedication of books by the club to the Public Library in honor of Bessie Lacy Dewey.

### **LS20BUC** The Buttercup Book Club. Organized 1903.

One item in good condition. Minutes of an adolescent book club from 1903-1907. Many comments on poetry, the food and the merry go round.

### LS15CBC Carolina Book Club. Organized 1939.

Condition poor to excellent. 1940 programs needs restoration of fragile cover. Programs run from 1940to 1967 complete and one from 1974-75. Program information contains monthly theme, membership, hostess, location, meeting dates, officers, and books discussed. Three items of correspondence from the 1945 club president, Mrs. Joe W. Reynolds. Dated 6/25/45 from Charles R. Brockman, Assistant Director of Charlotte Public Library requesting a list of membership.

### LS35Ch Chelidion Book Club.

Programs date from 1909 to 1937 with some years missing. Each contains a list of members, papers delivered by members, dates and locations of meetings. There is also a minute book from 1901 to 1928.

### LS38CON Contemporary Book Club.

Four programs from 1949 to 1960 with some years missing. Each is in good condition. Program information contains monthly theme, membership, hostess, and location, meeting dates, officers, discussion topics and speaker.

#### LS16CoBC Cover to Cover Book Club.

Two programs from 1926-27 and 1944-45. Identifies discussion topics with emphasis on world events.

### **LS2CRA** Cranford Book Club. Organized in 1892.

This is the oldest book club in Charlotte. Many of the early members were some of the city's strongest civic leaders, who founded hospitals, became the first state president of the PTA and established a school for women. The club's name is from a character in Ellen Gaskell's book Cranford because like some of the characters in the book, many of the club's early members were single. Collection contains the club's history recorded in March 6, 1942. Programs from 1905 to 1968 with years missing. There are four items of correspondence, two newspaper clippings and minutes of the meetings to 1996. Some pages are missing from the minutes. Very large collection in five boxes.

### **LS46CT** Current Topics Book Club. Organized in 1918.

Programs run from 1919 to 1934 with some yeas missing. Each program lists the members, topics for the meeting, and discussion questions.

### LS44DM Dolly Madison Book Club

Programs run from 1903 to 1947. Each monthly program contains discussion topics, officers, committee members with their addresses, telephone numbers, meeting date, hostess and presenter.

#### LS39ECL Eclectic Book Club.

Only one item from 1941-42 program. Lists officers, program committees, members, meeting dates, hostess, discussion topics.

#### LS10EV El Viernes Book Club.

Two items consist of two programs from 1931-32 and 1932-33. Each lists discussion topics, meeting date, hostess, names of members with phone numbers.

### **LS8EN** Entre Nous Book Club. Organized in 1926 [?]

Contains eight items from 1931-1950. Each monthly program contains discussion topics, officers, and committee members with their addresses, telephone numbers, meeting date, hostess and presenter.

#### LS42EP Epitome Book Club.

One program from 1937 to 1938. Names of officers and members with their addresses and telephone numbers.

#### LS43EX Ex Libris Book Club.

Twelve items from 1933 to 1960. Poor to fair condition. Each monthly program contains discussion topics, officers, committee members with their addresses, telephone numbers, meeting date, hostess and presenter, as well as clubs Constitution and by-laws.

### LS19FF Facts and Fun Book Club

One program from 1946-47 contains discussion issues from literature to social issues.

### **LS4FOR** Fortnightly Book Club. Organized in 1925.

Contains sixty-four programs from 1925 to 1968. Each monthly program contains discussion topics, officers, and committee members with their addresses, telephone numbers, meeting date, hostess and presenter. Twelve-minute books from 1925 to 1965 with few gaps. Two letters of invitation to join the club, one letter of acceptance, a list of past presidents, a list of favorite authors by Fannie Thomas, a stickpin and a newspaper clipping.

### **LS17FABC** Friday Afternoon Book Club. Davidson, North Carolina

Two programs from 1906-07 and 1908.

### **LS14FM** The Friday Morning Book Club. Organized 1940s. Two programs from

1944-45 and 1948-49. Each monthly program contains discussion topics, officers, and committee members with their addresses, telephone numbers, meeting date, hostess and presenter.

#### LS30GC Gleaners Club.

Four items in fair condition. Programs 1941-42, 1955-56, 1956-57 and 1958-1959. Each monthly program contains discussion topics, officers, and committee members with their addresses, telephone numbers, meeting date, hostess and presenter.

### LS21HBC Halycyon Book Club.

One program from 1948-1949. Each monthly program contains discussion topics, officers, and committee members with their addresses, telephone numbers, meeting date, hostess and presenter.

Item is in critical condition to paper. One program for 1947-48.

#### LS12QC The Quest Book Club.

Four programs from 1929-1944. Each monthly program contains discussion topics, officers, and committee members with their addresses, telephone numbers, meeting date, hostess and presenter.

#### LS49Ra Raedan Book Club

One program 1938-1939.

#### LS5RREV Readers Review Book Club.

Two items from 1938-39 and 1944-45. (Latter about the home front during WWII.) Each monthly program contains discussion topics, officers, and committee members with their addresses, telephone numbers, meeting date, hostess and presenter.

#### **LS7REN** Renaissance Book Club. Organized 1920-1924

Four programs: 1920-21, 1921-22, 1922-23, 1923-24. The group disbanded in 1924.

## **LS1RES** Research Book Club. Organized October 3, 1913.

Items are in three boxes from fragile to good condition.

Seventy-three programs from 1915 to 1969. Minutes from 1942 to 1972. One very fragile scrapbook contains copy of minutes of the first meeting in 1913 with summaries from 1914-1918. Along with history and bookmomentos, letters, photographs of members, as well as newspaper clippings, and photographs from 1946. Last formal meeting held in 1972. At the time, it was the second oldest book club in Charlotte. Each monthly program contains discussion topics, officers, and committee members with their addresses, telephone numbers, meeting date, hostess and presenter.

#### LS23REVS The Reviewers Club

Twelve items in good condition. Programs from 1925-1949 with some years missing. Each monthly program contains discussion topics, officers, and committee members with their addresses, telephone numbers, meeting date, hostess and presenter.

### LS24RT The Richard Tiddy Book Club

Six items in good condition. Programs from 1912-1920 with some years missing. Each monthly program contains discussion topics, officers, and committee members with their addresses, telephone numbers, meeting date, hostess and presenter.
