Julia McNinch was born in 1891, in Charlotte, North Carolina, to Samuel Sylvanus McNinch and Julia Magill McNinch. Julia was a schoolteacher, and married John Klump Slear of Pennsylvania, who had been a soldier, training at Camp Greene. She died in February 1975 in Charlotte.
