ABSTRACT

The Shuffletown area is located around Bellhaven and Mt. Holly-Huntersville Roads. There is some debate over how the area obtained its name, with seemingly no one knowing which version is correct. It began as a small farming community northwest of Charlotte, near Mountain Island. The Rozzelle family had run a ferry on the nearby Catawba River since the 1700s, and gradually, other stores grew up around the area as well. Shuffletown was also known for its dragstrip for many years.

Little remains of Shuffletown today other than memories. Many of the original homes and businesses, along with the dragstrip, have been demolished and replaced. The area continues to be remembered by some residents, however, and the community retains the Cooks Community Volunteer Fire and Rescue, and the Shuffletown Park.
