ABSTRACT

William Erskine Ardrey was born in 1839 in Mecklenburg County, North Carolina. He enlisted in the Confederate Army as a Private in Company K, 30th North Carolina Infantry, later advanced to Captain, and served for the duration of the war. Following the war's end, he was a farmer, and served as a representative in the State Legislature. Captain Ardrey died in 1907 in Mecklenburg County, and was buried in the Harrison United Methodist Church Cemetery, in Pineville.
